- Closed-toe shoes for activities, flip-flops for showers
- Hats for sun protection

## **Please Leave at Home**

- Tank tops of any kind
- Spaghetti-strap tops, crop tops, or midriff-revealing shirts
- Two-piece swimsuits (except modest tankinis)
- Clothing that is tight, sheer, or revealing
- T-shirts with crude, suggestive, or questionable images or wording
- Clothing promoting alcohol, drugs, or inappropriate themes
